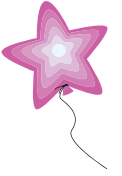




PAST SIMPLE



Past simple is used when reporting about something that happened in the past.
- usually in combination with time specification, e.g: yesterday, last week etc.

regular form:

play - played
listen - listened
jump - jumped
want - wanted

irregular form:

is - was
are - were
do - did
go - went

Yesterday I **was** at the cinema.
He **did** his homework **last week**.
Was there an accident **last Monday**?

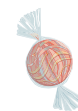
Joe gave him a lovely blue sweater.
